**The Nomination Committee is working to find people to serve on the board when some of the board members complete their three-year term at the end of June this year. The people on the Nominations Committee are:**

**The Nomination Committee will be working to solicit candidates for each of the positions that are rotating off. The Emmaus community will vote on the candidates at the May Gathering, Sunday May 17, 2020. Each board position needs helpers, i.e. a committee, to fulfill their responsibilities. The positions that need to be filled are highlighted in BLUE.**

**Who is on the Emmaus Board and what do they do?**

**Agape: Silvia Norris, (937) 207-4863. The Agape chairperson coordinates all the agape that is received and assures that it gets distributed during the walk. This includes the table agape, bed agape, the personal agape and the community agape.**

**Community Lay Director (CLD): Vic Neves, (937) 241-1025. The Community Lay Director leads the Emmaus board meetings and numerous other needed meetings. The Community Lay Director leads the gatherings and is the primary person who communicates with the Upper Room Ministries on all Springfield Area Emmaus walks and other correspondence. The Community Lay Director arranges with High Street for all walks, gatherings, and board meetings. This is a one year term in this role, then the CLD serves another year as Leadership. CLD candidates must have served on the Board in the past 10 years, and as an ALD (at least) on a team.**

**Fourth Day Coordinator: Melody Leonard, (937) 572-7482. The Fourth Day Coordinator helps people get into Share Groups, particularly pilgrims who has just completed their walk.**

**High Street Representative: Larry Lytle, (937) 323-1529. The High Street Representative is the liaison between High Street UMC and the Emmaus community. The High Street Representative brings to the board any relevant information or concerns regarding Emmaus' use of the building, and relays information back to High Street as needed.**

**Kitchen: Dana Johnson, (937) 831-6014. The Kitchen coordinator is responsible for the activities in the kitchen for all the prepared meals during a walk. The Kitchen Coordinator arranges for leaders for each meal and assures that signup sheets for meal helpers are available at the gatherings that precede a walk. The Kitchen coordinator prepares a shopping list for the supplies to give to the Purchasing/Supply Chairperson.**

**Leadership: Alison Nosker, (937) 673-4587. The Leadership chairperson is the Community Lay Director from the previous year. The Leadership chairperson assists the Community Lay Director as needed. The Leadership chairperson is also responsible for and chairs the Team Selection Committee.**

**Logistics Coordinator: Currently Vacant – contact Vic Neves (CLD) with questions/interest. The Logistics Coordinator leads the team that sets up (and later restores) the conference room and the rooms in the building that are used as sleeping areas for the team and pilgrims. The Logistics Coordinator ensures that there are sufficient helpers to clean bathrooms during the walk. The**

**Logistics Coordinator ensures that someone is available to open and lock up High Street UMC for the gatherings.**

**Music Coordinator: Derf Page, (937) 207-5040. The Music Coordinator assures that there is music provided at all gatherings, including communion. The Music Also the Music chairperson arranges for communion music at walk candlelights and closings. The Music chairperson offers assistance to walk Music Directors, as needed.**

**Newsletter: Rita Beedy, (937) 360-5633. The Newsletter Chairperson compiles the inputs from the Community Spiritual Directors, the Community Lay Director and any others and builds and distributes the monthly Emmaus newsletter via email.**

**Nurturing Coordinator: Sandy Johnson, (937) 831-6021. The Nurturing Coordinator is to display enthusiasm for Emmaus and to focus on extending hospitality during Walks and at Gatherings. Kairos and Chrysalis are sub-committees to the Nurturing Coordinator**

**Registrar: Verna Reed, (937) 831-1270. The Registrar receives the pilgrim applications and contacts the pilgrims via mail to confirm their attendance for a walk. The Registrar also manages the registration table on Thursday evening of each walk.**

**Secretary: Shelley Canan, (937) 308-1036. The Secretary takes minutes at every board meeting. The Secretary is also the keeper of the board history and records.**

**Social: Betty Reed, (937) 215-0913. The Social Chairperson arranges for the social gathering before every gathering, as well as the Thursday night Send-off meal and the post-closing Sunday meal of walk weekends. This includes set up, tear down, preparation of drinks, taking trash out and numerous other miscellaneous tasks.**

**Spiritual Directors: Rev Sherri Blackwell, (937) 271-4202, and Rev Kym James, (937) 561-2366. Spiritual Directors lead the communion service of the gatherings, as well as the candlelights, and closings of a walk. Spiritual Directors keep a record of all clergy who are eligible to serve as Weekend Spiritual Directors, help arrange for Weekend Spiritual Directors, and support the team selection, and the conduct of the walks. They assist the Emmaus community in many ways.**

**Sponsorship: Janine Sheaffer, (937) 869-0908. The Sponsorship chairperson provides periodic sponsorship training for Emmaus community members. The Sponsorship chairperson provides information to sponsors when their pilgrim has committed to a walk.**

**Purchasing/Supply Coordinator: Brian Case, (937) 663-0356. The Purchasing/Supply Coordinator is responsible for shopping for the groceries and supplies that the Kitchen Coordinator requires, and well as the purchasing of the purple worship books and other materials used on walks. The Coordinator also assures that all the supplies used during a walk are available. This includes the pilgrim notebooks, pens, craft supplies, personal items, aspirin and other medical items, etc.**

**Treasurer: Terry Johnson, (937) 206-7136. The Treasurer is the keeper of the funds and accounts, and is responsible for paying the community's bills. The treasurer also assures that our books get audited by an independent (non-Emmaus-affiliated) person each year.**

**Worship: Sherry Porter, (937) 284-3118. The Worship chairperson arranges for the communion elements for gatherings, candlelights, and closings. Also, the Worship chairperson sets up the prayer chapel for the walks.**

*There will be training offered in August for all board members, as well as any interested community members. This training helps explain the WHY behind Emmaus Ministries' activities and **all community***

**members are encouraged to attend.** Each board member has other responsibilities beyond what is described here. ALL BOARD MEMBERS benefit from having helpers. So, there are many ways for someone to help – if you have questions, or would like to help out in some way, feel free to contact them. They would love to hear from you! We are all God's hands and feet together; no one person does it alone.

If you are interested in serving on the board or on a committee supporting the board, please contact any of the Nomination Committee members listed above.
