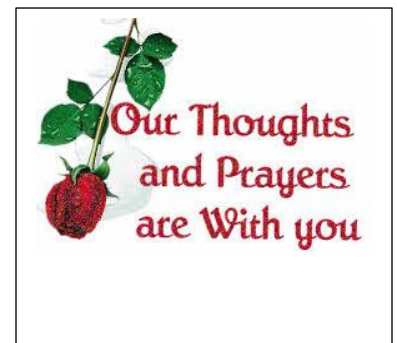


## Sympathies for your loved ones Home going
