Imitating Christ's Humility

- ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death even death on a cross!

¹⁴ Do everything without grumbling or arguing, ¹⁵ so that you may become blameless and pure, "children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation." Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky ¹⁶ as you hold firmly to the word of life. And then I will be able to boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor in vain. ¹⁷ But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. ¹⁸ So you too should be glad and rejoice with me.

HELP SET UP!!! The church gets set up on Wednesday evening, 19 June starting around 4 pm and goes until we are done. Air mattresses get blown up, the kitchen gets set up, and the conference room gets set up and more. Just drop in, and you will be put to work for the Lord!

MAKE AGAPE!!! We need Agape for the beds, and the tables for meals. Get your Share Groups to put something together – make sure to have enough for 55 people. We have not had as much Agape lately as we have had for past walks, so let's get started now! Can't wait to see what imaginative Agape you all can come up with!
