FROM OUR CO-SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR:

The sun is staying out longer, the trees are budding, birds are returning, and I'm not even going to complain "much" about the yard needing to be mowed. (I may need to revisit that statement as June gets here and I'm tired of mowing the yard.) Back to what I was saying, this is a time of year that brings things brand new. There is a freshness in the air, and amazing beauty as we enjoy God's creation.

With those thoughts I would like to share a scripture with you from John 21:15-19

15 When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?"

"Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Feed my lambs."

16 Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love me?"

He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep."

17 The third time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?"

Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you."

Jesus said, "Feed my sheep. **18** Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." **19** Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, "Follow me!"

Peter had been going down a pretty rough stretch of time over the past few days. He had seen Jesus die, heard of the resurrection, which is great but there had to have been one thing on his mind that he just couldn't shake. He denied Christ, even though he said he wouldn't. Even worse is that he didn't just deny Jesus once. He did it three times just as Jesus had told him he would, and the last time he had looked Jesus in the eye was after the third denial (Luke 22:61). Can you imagine how difficult that must've been? Now, in our scripture we see Jesus asking Peter, "Do you love me?" He doesn't ask this just once, He asks Peter three times. Of course Peter responds with, "Yes Lord, I Love You." Then Jesus says, "Feed my sheep" Feed my sheep. Peter denied Jesus three times, and Jesus restored Peter three times, but each time asked Peter to do something because of his love for Jesus.

I am excited to see the direction we are going as a Community. With a Men's Walk coming up, I ask all of you to keep the team and pilgrims in your prayers as we work to Feed God's Sheep. Please pray for those who so graciously give of their time and efforts to work "behind the scenes" to make the Walk so special for those attending. Feeding His Sheep. Pray for those serving on the Board, for those who attend Gatherings, for those who would like to attend but can't.

The point I am trying to make is that we have all denied Jesus at one time or another. He has also asked each of us if we love Him. What is your answer? Hopefully, it's a resounding YES! While some countries have a multi-century history of a day to celebrate mothers, the modern American version of the holiday began in the United States in the early 20th century at the initiative of Anna Jarvis, who organized the first Mother's Day service of worship and celebration at Andrews Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia, which serves as the International Mother's Day Shrine today.^[1]

The American version of Mother's Day has been criticized for having become too commercialized.^{[7][8]} Jarvis herself, who began the celebration as a liturgical observance, regretted this commercialism and expressed that this was never her intention.^[1]
