#### **Thoughts from one of your Spiritual Directors**

In Psalm 35, we see the Psalmist, David, asking the Lord Almighty to help him against those who try to inflict pain for no reason. When our enemies are unjust and lie about us, even when we do good to them, we can appeal to the Lord our God who is always just. Our enemies though are not always people; they may be situations, circumstances, and attitudes or other matters of the heart. Yes, this Psalm may sound harsh but David was fleeing from men who were unjustly seeking to kill him. I would like you to encourage you to read this Psalm and think about the situations, circumstances, attitudes or yes, even relationships that are seeking to destroy your heart.

A mentor has reminded me that sometimes life can feel too tight like a shoe. Sometimes we can be overwhelmed with commitments, which cause sleepless nights. We can spend several hours rehearsing everything we have to do and can't possibly get it done. Therefore, we're tempted to blame others or to wallow in mire of self-pity.

My mentor suggests laughing it off because sometimes life can be taken way to seriously. I invite you to join my mentor and I to laugh a little.

A day without a crisis is a total loss.

The other line always moves faster.

Inside every large problem are a bunch of little ones struggling to get out.

Whatever hits the fan will not be evenly distributed.

Friends come and go, but enemies accumulate.

The repairman will never have seen a model quite like yours before.

There's never time to do it right, but there's always time to do it over.

If you try to please everybody, nobody will like it.

When a broken appliance or car is demonstrated for the repairman, it will work perfectly.

There's a committee somewhere right now planning your future, and you were not invited to the meeting.

That's just a few. I feel better. How about you?

Laughter always makes me feel better. It is like a shield protecting me from the assaults of crisis.
