



Curiosities of the Bible (KJV): A man in prison counted the letters, etc. contained in the Bible and scratched several numbers on the stone walls with a nail. When his work was discovered, he was furnished with writing utensils and ordered to make a copy of the results of his works. Upon completion, he would be granted his freedom. Here's what he discovered: The Bible contains 3,566,480 letters; 773,746 words; 31,173 verses; 1,195 chapters; and 66 books. The word "Lord" appears 1,853 times; the word Jehovah 6,855 times; and the word "reverend" but once - Psalm 111:9. Ezra 7:21 contains all the letters of the alphabet except the letter "j." II Kings 19 and Isaiah 37 are alike. Esther 8:9 has the longest verse, while John 11:35 has the shortest. Most inspiring promises are in John 6:37; 14:2; and Matt 11:28 and Psalm 37:4. Psalm 23 is the most beautiful chapter in the Bible.
