

## FROM OUR CO-SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

"In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" (Isaiah 6:1-8)

When Noah was visited by the Lord, he yielded and built the ark, when Moses saw God in the burning bush, he yielded and lead the children of Israel out of Egypt, when the Lord spoke to Joshua, he yielded and the wall of Jericho fell, when God said to Enoch, "come take a walk with me", he went and God took him to Heaven. When Elijah saw and heard from God, he yielded and caught a ride on a whirlwind in a chariot of fire. When David heard from God, he yielded and poured his heart out into song, the Psalms. When Thomas saw Jesus, he cried, "My Lord and my God." When Peter yielded, he was filled with the Holy Ghost and preached a sermon that resulted in 3000 being saved. When Steven saw Jesus on the right hand of God, he submitted / yielded, and asked for forgiveness for those who stoned him. When Paul saw the Lord he cried, "What will you have me to do?" Then he yielded and became the greatest missionary who ever lived.

**Prayer to the Holy Spirit** Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth. O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit did instruct the hearts of the faithful, Grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy your consolations. Amen

What happened to Isaiah was an undeniable, awesome experience when he saw the presence of the Lord. When he saw the presence of the Lord, he saw himself. He saw his sin, his faults, his weaknesses. When he saw the presence of the Lord, he wanted to do something. He was compelled to do something for God. Therefore, when God put the call out there, "Who shall we send?", Isaiah immediately answered it with "Here I am." When Isaiah yielded to the Lord's calling, his world was changed, and the world around him was changed.

When was the last time you were in the presence of the Lord and fully yielded to Him. When was the last time you saw who you were, answered the call, and saw your world and the world around you changed. All because you yielded.

DL Moody, a 19th century evangelist once said, "it is yet to be seen what God can do with someone that has totally yielded to the Lord, for the Glory of God." DL Moody did a great work for the Lord. He saw many lives changed, but on his death bed, he once again said, "it is yet to be seen what God can do with a man that has totally yielded to the Lord, for the Glory of God."

Now is the time to yield yourself to God. Now is the time to see God and allow him to see you. Now is time to find the Holy of Holies, let the coals touch your lips, let God become real in your life, and see your world changed.

#### **BOARD POSITION INFO**

<u>Worship:</u> The Worship chairperson arranges for the communion for gatherings, candlelights, and closings. The Worship chairperson sets up the prayer chapel for the walks. (this position needs filled )

Agape: The Agape chairperson coordinates all the agape that is received and assures that it gets distributed during the walk. This includes the table agape, the personal agape and the community agape.

High Street Representative: The High Street Representative is the liaison between High Street UMC and the Emmaus Community. The High Street Rep. brings to the board any relevant information or concerns regarding Emmaus' use of the building, and relays information back to High Street UMC as needed.

Kitchen: The Kitchen coordinator is responsible for the activities in the kitchen for all the prepared meals during the walks. The Kitchen coordinator arranges for leaders of each meal and assures that signup sheets for meal helpers are available at the gatherings that precede a walk. The Kitchen coordinator prepares a shopping list for the supplies to give to the Purchasing Chairperson.

Purchasing/Supply: The Purchasing Chairperson is responsible for shopping for the groceries and supplies the Kitchen coordinator identifies as well as purchasing of the purple worship books and other materials for the walk. The Supply chairperson assures that all the supplies used during a walk are available. This includes the Pilgrim notebooks, pens, craft supplies, personal items, aspirin and other medical items, etc.

Logistics: The Logistics coordinator leads the team that sets up and tears down the rooms in the building that are used as sleeping areas for the team and pilgrims. The Logistics coordinator assures that there are sufficient helpers to clean the bathrooms during the walks.
